6th Form Art Scholarships at Mount House

Art at Mount House is a huge strength both in terms of the exam results achieved and the quality and breath of the co-curricular art opportunities available. Mount House offer a small number of Art scholarships each year to 6th Form students who plan to study A level Art, Textiles or Photography and who demonstrate a commitment to the wider life of the school through the co-curricular programme.

Art Scholars are required to work hard, to contribute positively to the life of the School and to be a credit to the School. Scholars must adhere to the School's required standards of conduct and progress and are expected to act as role models to other students and adhere to the Mount House School Values.

Art Scholarships can either be honorary and come with no monetary value, or they can be worth up to a maximum of 20% of the annual fee. Mount House School has a limited budget for scholarships, and applications for monetary awards should be made between 1st January and 1st March 2021. Applications outside this window can only be considered if there are if funds still available.

Art Scholars will meet termly, as a group, with the Head Mrs Richardson and Heads of Art, Mrs Baird and Mrs Somerville and will have a 1:1 review during the Spring Term each year.

In the unlikely event that a student does not live up to the expectations of our scholars, the School reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship.

If your son or daughter would like to be considered for a scholarship, please prepare a hand-written letter of application from the student, explaining why they believe they could be a Mount House Art Scholar. This should be no more than one side of A4. Please also submit a portfolio of their work for review, part of which should be GCSE work.

All applicants will be invited to an interview with the Head.
