As a member of the Southbank Sinfonia I was able to collaborate with the BBC Concert Orchestra, Academy of St-Martin-in-the-Fields and the Royal Opera House; I have also worked with the Philharmonia Orchestra and the London Contemporary Orchestra. I have also worked in other genres too, playing principal cello for the likes of Deep Purple and Phantom of the Opera.

I am very passionate about teaching, and apart from Mount

House, I also currently have students at Queen Mary University of London, the Cavendish School, and my own private studio. In terms of ages and standards, over the years my students have ranged from five years old to octogenarian, and from complete beginner to ABRSM diploma standard.
